





Dont share brushes or combs.




Wash your hands before eating and after using the bathroom



Eat healthy foods for healthy bodies.




Only drink safe water.

Babies shouldnt eat paint chips. They may contain a poison called lead.




Always use a tissue when you cough or sneeze.




Finger sticks at the doctor's office help make sure you are healthy.



Immunizations (shots) keep you healthy.






#### What is the State Hygienic Lab?

Your health is very important to the State Hygienic Laboratory at the University of Iowa. What is a Hygienic Lab? Hygienic means to help people be as healthy as possible. A laboratory (or "lab") is a place where scientists work to find answers. The Hygienic Lab, then, is a laboratory where scientists work to find ways to help you and other Iowans stay healthy.

Our scientists help doctors know if people have the flu or other diseases. We test the water you drink to make sure it is the best it can be. We also collect samples of air from all over the state to see how clean it is. People who work in our lab make sure that the families of babies born in Iowa know if these newborns need any special medicines or food.

So you see, we care about your health from the day you were born, and we will help keep you healthy as you grow.
